It is always very exciting for us to finish up the report for the month of August so that we can see how the Lord has blessed the ministry the previous year. We thought we would take the time to share with you, our ministry partners, what God did in the ministry year of September 2023-August 2024 in the Greater Huntington Chapter.

There were:

- 94 total ministries conducted
- 13,327 total children reached with the Gospel
- 189 total 1st time salvation decisions made
- And 45 unchurched children were established in local Bible believing churches

Praise the Lord for these types of results! Because you have invested your time, prayers, and finances into this ministry, these Kingdom results could take place. Eternity has been impacted through you!

We cannot even begin to thank you enough. Words are not adequate enough, but that's all we have to give. You allow this ministry to move forward, and we are so grateful. A Time to Keep Silence

ave you ever said to someone, "You need to stop talking."? Has anyone ever said that to you? If you're like me the answer is a resounding, "Yes." Especially in a social setting, we sometimes need someone to step in and tell us to stop talking and start listening. The same can be said of our growth as followers of Christ.

We are told this many times in Scripture including Ecclesiastes 3:7 which says, "...A time to keep silence, And a time to speak..." Our default human nature is one of speaking, especially with Christians. When we are together, we talk to and with one another. But there are times when we need to practice silence. Silence allows us to break into our default and truly learn to listen and relate to others.

Jesus, being the perfect model, practiced silence and solitude. All four gospels speak of different times where He would withdraw from the crowds, even from His disciples, to pray. As believers, we should follow His example and seek occasional times to withdraw from the routines of life for times of prayer and solitude. We have to be intentional about this because it requires us to maintain that temporary distance from community (family, work, church, etc.).

James also teaches of the power and dangers of the tongue, and how followers of Christ are required to strive to restrain it. Believers that are truly growing in their faith are those that are learning to balance silence and speech.

As Christians we must live in regular community and use wise speech, but to do so we have to practice occasional and temporary times of withdrawal. This is necessary to make us better able to serve others from our times of intentional prayer,

study, and fellowship with the Lord. We have to learn to exercise self control, which very well, may be the hardest part of the Fruit of the Spirit to apply. Silence and solitude are definitely not ends, but rather means that the Holy Spirit uses to bring us more into the image of Christ as we are to be.
